## **WORTHING INDOOR BOWLS CLUB**

This Document supersedes all previous versions of WIBC Bye-Laws and WIBC Rules

### **RULES**

1. The Club will be known as Worthing Indoor Bowls Club (WIBC)
2. The Club shall be affiliated to the English Indoor Bowling Association Limited (EIBA) and all games shall be played in accordance with the EIBA Rules.
3. The Officers of the Club shall be the President (2 year office), Chairperson (3 year office), Club Captain, Captain and two Vice Captains, Match Secretary, League Secretary, Competition Secretary, Club Membership Recruitment and Retention Officer, Benevolent Officer, Minute Secretary.
4. The Business of the Club shall be managed by a Bowls Committee consisting of the Officers of the Club the SCIBA & SCWIBA Representatives and two elected Bowls Committee Members. In the event of a vacancy arising in their number, the Committee may continue to act providing the number of Members is not reduced to less than six.
5. In the first year (2019), there will be a Bowls Steering Committee in place. The Bowls Steering Committee will appoint the Honorary President for a period of two complete years.

In subsequent years (2020 onwards) the Officers and Committee shall be elected annually at an Ordinary General Meeting to be held annually in April. In the event of a tie the chairperson will have a casting vote. Candidates for office will be proposed and seconded by two Members of the Club on the prescribed nomination form which shall also be signed by the Candidate signifying their willingness to accept nomination not less than 7 days before the Ordinary General Meeting. The names of the candidate, the office for which he/she is nominated, and the names of the proposer and seconder shall be immediately displayed on the Notice Board.

Once the elected Committee is in place, they will be charged with selection of candidates for the subsequent incoming President within the prescribed time scales.

6. The Bowls Committee may make recommendation to amend Club Rules for the purpose of the proper conduct and management of the affairs of the Club, providing that such rules are not inconsistent with the Articles of Association and published Bye-Laws of the Company.
7. The Bowls Committee shall have powers to form Sub-Committees as they deem necessary, to exercise such powers as the Committee shall confer on them.

8. The date, time and place of the Ordinary General Meeting of the Club together with the Agenda shall be advertised in the Club Premises in such manner as the Bowls Committee shall determine at least 21 days before the date set.
9. A Special General Meeting shall be summoned by the Appropriate Official: -
  - (a) At the request / discretion of the Bowls Committee
  - (b) Upon a requisition in writing by no less than 30 Members of the Club.
10. Notice of a Special General Meeting shall be given and the meeting conducted in the same manner prescribed for an Ordinary General Meeting.
11. With the approval of the Council of Management of the Company these Rules may be added to, repealed or amended by resolution at any Ordinary or Special General Meeting PROVIDED that no such resolution shall be deemed to have been passed unless carried by a majority of at least two-thirds of the Members voting thereon.
12. Where there is any conflict between any of the above Rules and any Club Bye Law the Bye Law(s) will take priority. Interpretation of all the Rules must be consistent with statutory requirements for CASCs (Community Amateur Sports Clubs as first provided for by the Finance Act 2002).
